Description of Incident

On the above date and time a team one call was activated for 7N A pod, while in route control went over the radio and stated that the inmates had barricaded themselves in the unit's rec room. I Lt. Pettis was now entering the unit when Capt. Morris radio me to retrieve the cell buster and the ICE Shield, I at this time was unaware how many inmates were involved. I directed Officer Hernandez to retrieve the cell buster from RH while I retrieved the ICE Shield from control. When I returned to the unit Capt. Morris was present at the rec room door along with several staff and he was attempting to gain compliance from the two inmates who were in the rec room. The inmates refused directives and continued to tie sheets to the rec room door and the workout equipment. As Capt. Morris administered a five second burst underneath the door, the inmates quickly placed a plastic bag under the door causing OC to traject back into the dayroom. I used to unit's coreless phone to contact SD Miller and brief him on the situation, he was advised that OC had been administered into the rec room and the inmates still refused to comply. He directed us to utilize the OC phantom, which is a stronger form of OC in a vapor. The inmates still refused to surrender as Capt. Morris left the unit to retrieve gas masks and the OC phantom as the team was now being effected by the OC. I directed control via radio to have staff retrieve the HEPPA filter as we continued to give directives to the inmates. Capt. Morris returned with gas masks and Sgt. Hansen who was armed with the OC launching system. At this time the inmate started to untie the sheets and were directed to get face down on the floor. When both inmate were secured on the floor, face down with their hands behind their backs, we discussed how we would strategically enter. One inmate placed himself to the right of the door and one inmate laid directly in front of the door, we discussed that I would secure the inmate to the right along with Officer's Taylor and Skinner and Capt. Morris would secure the inmate in front of the door with Officer's Flemming and Myles. Capt. Morris and I unholstered our X26P Tasers as we entered the rec room. Directives were given for the inmate to stay down as I approached the inmate on the right who was later identified as inmate [REDACTED] and Capt. Morris approached the inmate in front

of the door who was identified as inmate [REDACTED]. Inmate [REDACTED] was placed in wrist restraints, directed to his feet and escorted off the unit to RH. Capt. Morris followed with inmate [REDACTED]. Due to the inmates disruptive behavior I kept my X26P Taser in the high ready position during the escort. Inmate [REDACTED] during the escorted stated, he just gave us something to talk about at home and somebody had to do something about the dayrooms. Inmate [REDACTED] was escorted directly to the cell B23, where a staff assisted strip search was conducted and inmate [REDACTED] was placed in control status. Inmate [REDACTED] was allowed to decontaminate in the cell shower, he was advised what behavior needed to be displayed to be removed from control status, and he was offered medical attention, which he declined. Capt. Morris activated the purge system while nursing staff reported to 7N to assess other inmates on the unit. Staff were directed to take pictures of the rec room and cell 7A03 where the inmates were housed. Staff were debriefed, no injuries were reported, staff were allowed to view video footage and communication about staff response was held. Staff were directed to complete IR's, and the ADO was notified. UOF packet complete, Taser activation form complete, video footage downloaded. EOR.

1950 Nursing staff on unit assessing inmates, Capt. Morris on unit taking photo's of rec room, photo's also taken of inmates cell

2000 SD and ADO notified, staff debriefed, directed to complete IR's, Video footage downloaded and UOF packet complete, Taser activation form complete

 Several staff attempted to speak with inmates to gain voluntary compliance

 Supervisor deployed OC into recreation room. OC was ineffective at getting inmates to comply.
 Security Director authorized OC launcher and X26P Taser as show of force
 Inmates complied after show of force and were escorted to RH for controlled separation placement
 DOC-112 completed for controlled separation placement
 Inmates allowed to see HSU in addition to being offered a shower and new clothing
 Inmates issued conduct reports for behavior
 Staff debriefing completed with no injuries reported
